

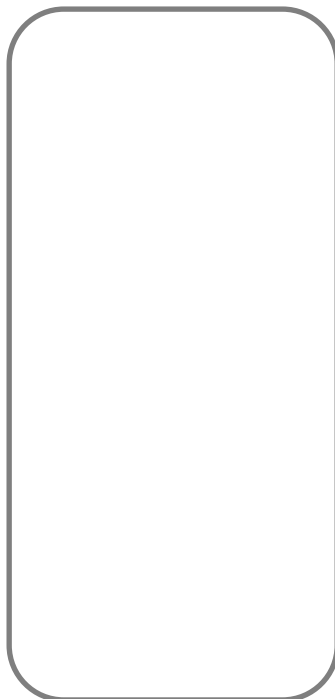

Over the two weeks, the main themes will focus on technique, tactics, soccer fitness & SAQ (Speed, Agility, Quickness):

The technical topics will include; passing, shooting, receiving the ball, heading, dribbling, turning and shielding the ball.

The fitness topics will include speed training, acceleration, agility, balance, explosive power, muscular endurance & flexibility.

Tactical topics will include all the major phases of the field game, namely attacking play, defensive play and midfield play.

In addition to the work done on the field, the coaching staff encourage all players to use break times to glean further knowledge on any and all aspects of the game.

To round out the enjoyment and to enhance the experience each day during the breaks there will be entertainment and the chance to win an array of prizes.
