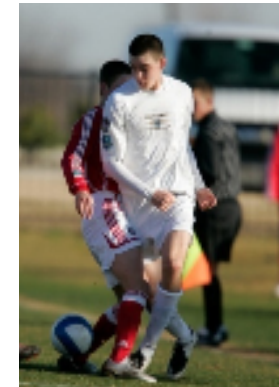

What is a Community Camp?

Seacoast United (SUSC) is now in its 15th year offering summer camps. Over the years our Community Camps have evolved into what we believe is a very fun, easy going but educational experience. Each and every SUSC camp is unique in that an entirely new curriculum is created within our daily framework to give every camper a special experience. Our coaches are hand selected to not only have top quality playing and coaching experience but to have great, outgoing personalities to which the kids can relate and have fun with.

Each day begins with a fun 'camp warm-up' which gets everyone loose and getting lots of touches on the ball. Then we split the camp into age appropriate groups and pair them with a coach for the week. As a group they play fun games and exercises which promote confidence with ball. Each day ends with scrimmage play which may be different from day to day but promotes every player to be involved as much as possible.

The last day of our camp has been dubbed "World Cup Day". This is a special day where all players are encouraged to dress up in whatever countries color they have been designated. Over the years we have seen face paint, hair colors, complete uniforms, even hats, scarves and lunch entrees! It is a full day of games to see which country is crowned as World Cup Champion!

3 & 4 yr old Grassroots Class

For your 3 & 4 yr olds, we offer a Grassroots class as part of our Community Camps! These parent-participation classes are designed to work on the most basic soccer fundamentals as well as motor skill and social development. Classes run from 9-10am each day of camp (includes Nike t-shirt) for \$55.

Paul Willis:

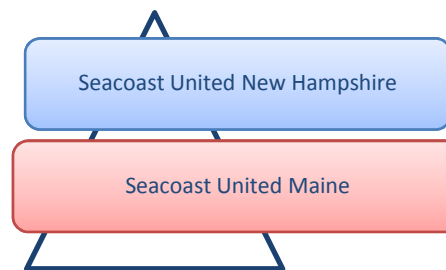
